- Deep Yellow 202,9 (off white)
- Deep Yellow 202,5 (yellow)
- Burnt Umber 409,3 (dark brown)
- Cobalt Blue 512,5 (blue)
- Carmine 318,5 (red)

Winsor Newton pastel: Paynes Gray 2,465  
(medium blue gray)

If you wish to buy a pastel kit (or individual pastels) I figure them at \$1.50/half stick. A full class kit would be \$12.00. Some of you have the basics if you've bought a kit from me before. Probably the white, black, burnt umber and the off white. Also, these are soft pastels if you have another brand feel free to bring them. I've given you generic descriptions so you can.

## **PAINTING TIPS – SUBMITTED BY BARBARA REVITT**

### **CHRISTMAS TIPS**

Tip 1 -- When you want to basecoat holiday projects with a vibrant red, be sure to use an Opaque Red. It provides beautiful coverage in just a couple of coats, unlike most other red paints. It's a fabulous product!! I'd be lost without it! Keep up the good work, Delta!

Tip 2 -- I have a lot of people excited about painting Holiday sweats and have found several did not know that you need to wash that garment before painting or you may see your hard work go down the drain.

Tip 3 -- Try painting birdhouses that look like gingerbread houses. Use a trompe l'oeil style to make candies on them such as peppermints (you know those swirly red and white ones?), M&M's, gumdrops, etc. Paint the rooftop white, then add tiny, multi-colored fabric paint lines (for dimension) to resemble those skinny sprinkles, or use the end of a fat paintbrush to make round dots like the other kind of sprinkles (the round ones). Use fabric paint, shiny white, to decorate the edges like piped icing. Really finishes them off nicely. You could use that dimensional paste stuff to make your own candies, too.

Tip 4 -- Paint wooden building blocks white or dark blue and then decorate them like they were Christmas pack-

ages....paint a bow, paint stars on one, hearts on another in a pattern like wrapping paper. Then for Christmas you can display them in a sleigh.

Tip 5 -- For great looking orange pumpkins, shade with a rusty red. When painting the cutout faces of pumpkins, undercoat them with white first, then base them with bright yellow.

Tip 6 -- In the Jewish faith, the word GOD must never be in print. Therefore, some sayings might be: Happy Channukah, Hannukah Cheer, Shalom (always safe on any Jewish themed piece.)

Chickadee Crunch

Raw suet	Pine Cones
Sunflower seeds	Millet seed

Put Suet through a meat grinder, then melt it down in a double boiler. Set aside to cool and harden slightly. Reheat. Take pinecones with string or wire attached and spoon warm suet over until well coated. L Sprinkle immediately with millet, then push sunflower seeds under scales. Spoon warm suet over piene cones again, building up suet and securing sunflower seeds. Refrigerate until firm and hand from tree branches.

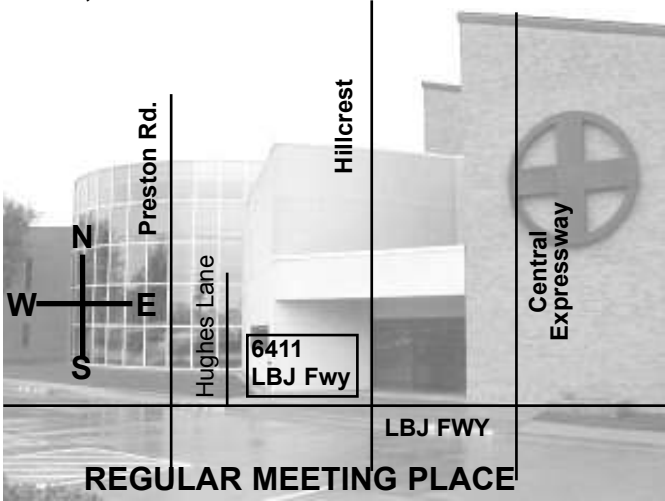
